### Adjudicators remarks -

#### Three Part Invention

1) Cornets are untidy at the start and you take a little while to settle. The tempo is steady and sounds a little laboured at times. Cornet parts are generally neat. All moves along nicely. Basses untidy at 70! These ending is a little out of control.

2) Parts rather heavy but horns play with good style. Some tuning issues arise at 200. There is good attention to detail but overall you don't allow the music to flow. Nice end at 34 but tuning again problematic in 48. Good control to close.

3) Good start: neat work from cornets and the tempo works! Perc. overdone in places but in general balance is good. Metre changes are effective and you maintain good style with only minor blemishes. Fine control in the final 1-144 section and I hear all the semi-quaver detail.

A mixed performance: the first two movements sounded rather heavy in terms of tempo, but the final movement really sparkled! Thank you!
